Featuring a collection of unsettling, atmospheric, and unforgettable horror stories from a diverse lineup of writers, *Eye See You* represents both a creative milestone and a celebration of independent fiction publishing.

While the road to publication came with inevitable challenges and delays, the successful release of *Eye See You* marks the beginning of a larger mission for TiF Press: publishing compelling fiction and building opportunities for writers across genres.
